The injured worker was questioned regarding his lack of co-operation with his prior Rehabilitation Counsellors, eg his failure to attend scheduled appointments. The worker states that he did attend one appointment in the London Regional Office but the Rehabilitation Counsellor failed to attend this appointment. The worker states that he then "wanted to get back at him" so subsequently missed several appointments. more Government Lies and

With respect to the worker's poor attendance on the upgrading programme, the worker stated that he had to go to court on many occasions, and stated that this could not be avoided. The worker did add that the court case in question is still ongoing but he expects to be settled soon.

The injured worker did mention that he wished to attend Fanshawe College in a 2 year respiratory technologist programme. However, the injured worker is not requesting the assistance of vocational rehabilitation services with regards to sponsorship on this program at this time. The worker states he plans to persue this request with Canada Manpower, and if denied to him by this agency, he indicated he would be requesting WCB sponsorship. Fraud (a. CUSIB

As noted above, it does not appear that the injured worker's situation has changed since denial of rehabilitation assistance in September of 1984.

The injured worker has received extensive rehabilitation services in the past, and there is no evidence to indicate a change in response to conselling or a willingness to co-operate.
